HELDENFELS TACKLES NEW BAYLOR STADIUM

Heldenfels Enterprises Incorporated (HEI) will supply precast concrete risers for Baylor's new 45,000 seat stadium. The Populous designed stadium sits on a 93-acre site located on the Brazos River, next to I-35 in Waco. Heldenfels bid on the project late last year through Dallas-based Austin Commercial, LP. Heldenfels has demonstrated their capabilities to undertake a project of this magnitude with their success of similar projects, including Cowboys Stadium, Reliant Stadium, and Minute Maid Field. Such endeavors in the precast industry require quality products and exceptional project management.

Heldenfels is expected to produce 185,000 square feet of risers for the new landmark in Waco. The company has teamed up with Lowe Precast of Waco to produce the approximate 1,400 pieces needed for construction. "The stadium will be the largest project in Central Texas history and has the potential to transform the city of Waco" (baylor-stadium.com). Completion of the new stadium is set for next summer and in time for the 2014 season opener.

Heldenfels has two manufacturing plants in Texas, one in Corpus Christi and other in San Marcos. Heldenfels maintains the presence in traditional construction markets—highway, marine and industrial—while continuing the tradition of building on technological advances to expand into new markets.
